1. Primary Purpose of the Post

Lead the development and delivery of Liverpool City Region Combined Authorities Inward Investment Service, Invest Liverpool City Region.

The primary objective of the role is to attract and secure significant investment into the Liverpool City Region, aligned to the CA's corporate objectives and the Mayor's Manifesto pledges. The role will also lead all trade activity, especially where it relates to joint inward investment and trade activities.

The role will be responsible for developing and implementing strategies to enhance the region's attractiveness to domestic and international investors, fostering relationships with key stakeholders at senior levels, and driving economic growth through targeted investment initiatives.

The Senior Lead Officer - Inward Investment will have full budgetary responsibility including the identification and securing of additional funding, alongside the Assistant Director - Business Growth.

The role will also have responsibility for leading delivery of Investment into the Freeport and Investment Zone and will work closely with the CA's Business and Enterprise and Cluster Boards in areas relating to Inward Investment.

The Senior Lead Officer - Inward Investment will lead the Invest Liverpool City Region team and will build and lead cross departmental teams and external partnerships to deliver activity.

2. Your responsibilities

- Have responsibility for and manage the Invest Liverpool City Region service to deliver inward investment into LCR
- Lead the development and implementation of a comprehensive inward investment strategy aligned with the economic goals of the Liverpool City Region, including



delivery of the Corporate Plan, Plan For Prosperity and Economic Opportunities Framework

- Manage the building of capacity and increase capability and resources within the Invest Liverpool City Region function.
- Target the key priority cluster and opportunities identified in the Economic Opportunities Framework to target new investment into Liverpool City Region, building market ready propositions.
- Take responsibility for and lead the development and delivery of a new strategy to attract Capital and Real Estate investment into Liverpool city Region, building capacity and capability
- Develop strategic relationships with local public and private sector stakeholders at senior levels (C Suite) and lead the development of an annual activity plan that will attract capital and real estate at events like MIPIM, UKREiiF
- Lead the delivery of investment related activity into Freeports and Investment Zones.
- Lead the proactive identification and engagement of potential investors, scaling Start Ups and SME's to Multinational Corporations.
- Direct and oversee market research and analysis to inform investment strategies and identify emerging opportunities.
- Develop International partnerships and collaboration with key target markets, at national, regional, city and industry association level at senior levels.
- Represent the Liverpool City Region at high level investment related events, including investment forums, trade shows, and business events including speaking opportunities and media appearances if required.
- Build and maintain strong relationships with local, national, and international stakeholders, including government agencies, industry bodies, and business leaders at senior levels.
- Manage relationships with constituent Local Authorities in matters relating to Inward Investment and represent the LCRCA at the LCR Inward Investment Board, Cabinet Briefings and Growth Directors.
- Perform secretariat duties for the Business Relocation Task Force.
- Represent the Inward Investment service at the Freeport/IZ joint board as required.
- Manage relationships with key government bodies, including DBT and OFI at senior levels including national and international forums.
- Lead and develop strategic partnerships with the private and public sector to support delivery of activity, including raising alternative sources of funding.
- Lead and oversee end-to-end management of investment projects, ensuring timely delivery and alignment with strategic objectives.
- Build and lead cross service internal teams and collaborations with external partners to facilitate successful project execution.
- Have responsibility for the creation of compelling investment propositions and collateral to attract and retain investors, working with the Cluster Boards and Cluster Leads.



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- Lead the development and implementation of activity plans with the objective of attracting new investment into Liverpool City Region.
- Coordinate with LVEP to align the wider Place Brand with inward investment branding and narrative.
- Manage the delivery of high profile national and international events such as MIPIM/UK REiiF and Industry Specific Events and Conferences.
- Provide feedback to the Mayors Office and the CA ELT and support the development of capacity to attract further inward investment and deliver economic growth objectives, including wider hard and soft infrastructure development.
- Identify and secure external funding to support delivery of ILCR and wider Business Growth Service.
- Monitor and evaluate the impact of inward investment activities, providing regular reports to ELT and external stakeholders.
- Set and achieve key performance indicators (KPIs) related to investment attraction and economic impact.
- Manage the delivery of external funding, ensuring financial compliance and achievement of outcomes and outputs.
- Provide support to the Assistant Director of Business Growth and support leadership across wider Business Growth objectives.
- Represent Assistant Director of Business Growth as required.
- Accompany the Mayor, CA Chief Executive, other political leaders and members of the CA ELT on foreign investment missions and field investment related elements of the discussion on behalf of the city region.

- Promote teamwork and collaborate proactively with their colleagues and management peers.
- Demonstrate 'whole organisation' thinking in the delivery of shared goals and objectives.
- Work in an agile and effective way to ensure that the CA's resources are used efficiently to achieve a positive impact.
- Communicate effectively orally and in writing.
- Demonstrate strong political awareness and cultural sensitivity.
- Manage people well to encourage optimal employee engagement and performance.
- Be skilled at managing change and dealing with potential conflict and resolution.
- Demonstrate a commitment to customer excellence.
