Purpose

Support the programming, planning and delivery of Wirral Museums Service's exhibitions programme; to include loaned-in exhibitions and collections displays and support the long-term redevelopment of the permanent collection displays.

The Exhibitions Officer will play a key role in ensuring the smooth running of the exhibitions programme, from concept to delivery, including supporting the long-term redevelopment of the permanent collection displays.

Main Duties And Responsibilities

Behavioural:

- Enjoy, achieve, create impact, and thrive in the role and organisation.
- Live our values in the role and organisation.

Team Leadership and Management:

- Disseminate relevant information about exhibitions to Museums Assistants.
- Supervise technicians on all stages of packing, installation and de-installation of exhibitions.
- Provide strong leadership, strengthening engagement, growth, culture, innovation, collaboration and performance.
- Assign responsibilities, setting clear expectations, and deliverables to team members and empower them to excel in their roles.
- Through continuous improvement strengthen the tools, practices and impact of the service.
- Attend exhibition launches and events as required to liaise with artists, partners, and stakeholders.
- Work alongside the Curator and Museums Manager to develop an exhibitions strategy. Leading the monthly exhibitions team meetings and presenting on the up-and-coming programme

Communication, Engagement and Training:

• Liaise with external and internal partners as necessary during all stages of planning, organisation, and delivery of exhibitions, e.g.: artists, contractors, lenders.

Work alongside the Digital Engagement Officer and Schools Resources Officer to help implement educational and marketing materials and events relating to the exhibitions programme.

Data Analysis and Decision-Making:

- Support the Curator in all aspects of exhibitions programme management. This includes object • lists, installation workflows, budget tracking, insurance, transport arrangements, condition checking, documentation, packing and unpacking; with responsibility for decision making over discrete projects.
- Undertake research into Wirral's collections with a view to refreshing permanent displays, developing temporary collections exhibitions, and supporting dissemination of information (including liaising with individual enquirers).
- Undertake manual handling of collection items and loaned works, having a good understanding of best practice collections handling, including recording movements in eHive.

Compliance:

Adhere to and comply with all relevant corporate policies and procedures including Health & Safety, General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), Corporate Governance and Code of Conduct.

- Key holder for the venue.
- Any other duties commensurate with the grade.
