PURPOSE

To support and advise primary headteachers and to represent them in all areas of consultation which effect the primary phase.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To represent Head teachers at a range of discussion/ consultation forums e.g. Safeguarding Children Partnership Board, School Forum, Admissions, Challenge Partnership Board, JCC, Alternative Provision Steering Group and other working parties deemed suitable etc. Ensure that forums are appropriately represented by appropriate school leaders.
- 2. To understand the national and local agendas so contributing to the development of primary education in Wirral.
- 3. To review current and planned legislation and provide regular updates for headteachers and Local Authority staff as changes arise, including maintained schools and primary academies.
- 4. To lead consultation with primary and primary special school headteachers to further refine policy and practice where required and agreed by PHCG and Assistant Director.
- 5. To co-ordinate cluster headteacher meetings and pre-PHCG meetings to ensure PHCG runs effectively and appropriately as per terms of reference and constitution.
- 6. To attend PHCG meetings and support the chair and vice chair, organise agendas, invitations, minutes and co-ordinate follow up actions.
- 7. Attend all cluster meetings for each locality providing essential LA feedback and ongoing communication.
- 8. Liaise with LA partners in School Improvement, Director, Assistant Director, Virtual Head, Inclusion Strategy Managers, SEND, Children's Services etc., to ensure full alignment providing feedback and receiving appropriate information to and from headteachers.
- 9. Being available to offer urgent advice to Headteachers when required.









- 10. Researching and responding to requests for information, advice and guidance.
- 11. Create a monthly report bringing together feedback form all groups and working parties etc. and share this with all Headteachers and relevant parties.
