Duties and Responsibilities

Support the work of KSCP Manager and the KSCP groups in delivering effective performance information and developing frameworks to support Quality Assurance

Play a significant role in supporting the Quality Assurance Framework in relation to S11 and Section 157/175 audits and facilitate challenge sessions with multi-agency partners

Develop and maintain multi-agency safeguarding performance datasets to support the partnership's priorities.

Collect, collate, and analyse data from across statutory and non-statutory partners (e.g. health, police, children's services, education).

Identify themes, trends, and areas of risk from performance and audit activity to inform strategic decision-making.



Support and coordinate the delivery of the multi-agency audit programme, including case file audits, deep dives, and learning reviews.

Maintain systems for recording, tracking and reviewing recommendations from case reviews and serious incidents.

Support the evaluation and impact measurement of partnership learning and improvement activity.

Ensure that learning from audits, reviews, and performance data is captured, communicated, and tracked to embed change.

Provide quality assurance advice and support to partnership subgroups and project teams.

Contribute to the development and implementation of the partnership's Quality Assurance Framework.

Produce regular reports and dashboards for the Partnership Board, subgroups, and Independent Scrutineer.

To assist in the preparation for statutory inspections and peer reviews.
